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Cuppa Tea Co.

Looking for a relaxing place to escape to during a busy day?

Cuppa Tea Co. may be just the place you need to rejuvenate your soul.

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The cheerful little building at 1 N. Morris St. in Richmond's Fan District opened in April and offers 60 specialty loose-leaf teas -- green, white, black and rooibus, a red tea.

Owners Lurline and Allan Wagner offer an afternoon tea and a lighter luncheon tea, as well as dessert teas (served with scones, cream and preserves) and Asian-style teas that come with Chinese dim sum and candied ginger coconut rice cakes.

Kettles are brought to the table and sit on individual warmers as you eat. If you're unsure about what kind of tea you want, servers come around to each table and open what looks like a wooden jewelry box. Inside are small silver canisters filled with tea leaves that customers can smell before they try a tea.

The menu changes quarterly, and the place caters to individual parties as well as bridal and baby showers, children's tea parties and other special occasions.

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
